

## REACH Information from Elektrisola Medical Technologies

Dear customer,

Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals (REACH) in Europe asks for registration of chemical substances in Europe after December 1, 2008. PTFE tubing is not required to be listed, as it is considered as an “article”, not as a chemical substance.

Elektrisola Medical Technologies relies on its suppliers for various forms of documentation to ensure their compliance to our policies. We maintain current certifications from our supplier’s stating compliance with REACH, RoHS, and the provisions of the Dodd-Frank Act concerning Conflict Minerals; all suppliers are qualified through rigorous testing of raw materials and tracking of delivery and quality performance. Current declaration letters stating their compliance with REACH are available for customer inspection at our facility. The below lists are identified in their certifications.
