

REACH Information from Elektrisola

Dear customer,

REACH (**R**egistration, **E**valuation and **A**uthorization of **C**hemicals) in Europe asks for registration of chemical substances in Europe after December 1, 2008. Polyimide Tubing is not required to be listed, as it is considered as an “article”, not as a chemical substance.

ECHA (European Chemicals Agency) has proposed enclosed list of chemicals, which should not be contained in articles of above 0.1 % (w/w) content. Hereby Elektrisola declares that our Polyimide Tubing products fully comply with the regulation of REACH with respect to:

- i. Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC)
